From Fr. Tim:

The Mississippi State Dept of Health recommends that people over 65 take extra precautions to avoid large crowds.

This advice is also for people with compromised immune systems or a history of chronic illness
The State Health Department also advises everyone to avoid crowds of 250 or more.

The Saint James Mass schedule remains the same.

The attendance at each of our five weekend Masses does not exceed 250.

We encourage all parishioners to safeguard their health and that of their families.
